SUMMARY

On 6/29/2017 at approximately 0100 hours, Officer Sahnic located an occupied stolen vehicle in the area of A Street and E Madill Street in Antioch. The driver of the vehicle (later identified as [REDACTED]) pulled into a nearby gas station and stopped the vehicle. Officer Sahnic attempted to call him out of the vehicle, and [REDACTED] started the engine, and drove off leading multiple officers on a high speed vehicle pursuit.

[REDACTED] eventually fled from the vehicle in the area of E 6th St and A St. He was located by Officer Harger and his K9 partner hiding under a vehicle near 51 E 6th Street, and was taken into custody without further incident. [REDACTED] was medically cleared after the K9 deployment, and booked into the Martinez Detention Facility for stolen vehicle charges and felony evasion.

INVESTIGATION

On 6/29/2017 I was routed this case for review and disposition. I reviewed Officer Sahnic's primary report as well as the supplemental reports submitted by Officers Harger, White, and Stenger. I also reviewed the photographic evidence as well as the recorded statements obtained during the course of their investigation.

On 6/29/2017 at approximately 1120 hours, I made telephone contact with the victim listed in the SVS return; [REDACTED] told me the following in summary:

She told me that on the morning of 6/22/2017 she was in San Francisco with her friends. She stated she drove her 2008 Mercedes 350 CA LIC [REDACTED] and parked it on 3rd Street in San Francisco where she went to "Sam's Bar and Grill". She said her vehicle was locked; however there may have been a spare key inside the vehicle. She stated upon return at approximately 0215 hours, she discovered her vehicle had been stolen. She said she then reported the theft to SFPD.

I asked [REDACTED] if she had ever heard of [REDACTED] she said she had not. I asked if he had permission to driver her vehicle, she said he did not. She told me she was the regular driver of the vehicle, and that nobody else drives the vehicle, or had permission to drive the vehicle. She valued the vehicle at \$20,000.00 and stated that is how much she still owed on the vehicle.

[REDACTED] had a copy of her registration and provided her VIN and license plate information to me, which was a match to the reported information collected by patrol. I completed the "Auto Theft Prop

115" document telephonically with [REDACTED] and provided her with the Antioch Police report number and my contact information. I requested the dispatch audio from the vehicle pursuit and will forward it to the Office of the District Attorney along with the original SFPD report upon receipt.

OPINION AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the observations and investigations by the officers involved in this incident, I recommend the felony charges of CVC 2800.2 evasion, CVC 10851(a) vehicle theft, and PC 496D(a) possession of a stolen vehicle be filed against [REDACTED]. I am also recommending a misdemeanor charge of PC 148(a)(1).

Please forward to the Office of the District Attorney for review and criminal disposition.
