NARRATIVE

On 06/29/2017, at approximately 0103 hours, I was working as a Police Officer for the City of Antioch. I was wearing a Police uniform with Antioch Police Department (APD) patches affixed to both shoulders. I was wearing a load bearing vest that had a silver star badge over my left breast. I was driving a Black and White patrol vehicle (1233) with APD decals on the vehicle. The vehicle is also equipped with an Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system. The vehicle also had operating overhead lights (to include a forward facing solid red light) and a siren. The equipment was checked and found to be in working order prior to the start of my shift.

I was driving N/B on A St approaching E Madill St when the ALPR system alerted to a stolen vehicle(LP [REDACTED]) in the left turn pocket on the S/B side of A St and E Madill St. The vehicle made a E/B turn on to E Madill St. I was able to get behind the vehicle as it began pulling into the Chevron Gas Station located at 2413 A St. Dispatch confirmed the vehicle was still stolen.

I advised dispatch of the license plate and activated my overhead emergency lights and "chirped" the siren twice. The driver of the vehicle, later identified as [REDACTED] stopped the vehicle on the west side of the fuel pumps. I exited my patrol vehicle and pointed my department issued firearm towards the vehicle. I gave two loud commands for the driver of the vehicle to turn of the vehicle. [REDACTED] opened the drivers side door and looked at my direction and said, "*What did I do*". I again ordered [REDACTED] to turn off the vehicle. [REDACTED] shut the door and turned off the vehicle.

[REDACTED] opened the door for a second time and asked, "*What did I do*". I ordered [REDACTED] to throw the keys outside of the vehicle, but [REDACTED] shut the door and turned the vehicle back on.

[REDACTED] began driving and exited from the gas station to go N/B on A St. A pursuit was initiated at 2413 A St. The vehicle took off at a high rate of speed. The vehicle was travelling at approximately 80MPH N/B on A St when it went through a solid red light at A St and W 18th St, which is a violation of CVC 21453(c). The vehicle continued N/B on A St and made a W/B turn on to W 15th St. The vehicle made a N/B turn on to C St

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and continued travelling N/B on C St at a high rate of speed. The vehicle failed to stop at a solid red posted STOP sign, which is violation of CVC 22450(a).

It appeared the vehicle had collided after losing control momentarily at C St and W 9th, but the vehicle regained control and made a W/B turn on to W8th St. I lost visual of the vehicle.

A short time later Officer Harger advised the vehicle was travelling E/B on W6th from G St. A/ Sgt Stenger and Officer Harger re-initiated the pursuit where the pursuit terminated at E 6th St and Mcheleny Rd. A Sgt Stenger observed as [REDACTED] foot bailed from the driver's side of the vehicle and ran N/B through residential back yards (Refer to A/ Sgt Stenger's report for further details).

Officer Harger and PSD Donna were able to apprehend [REDACTED] hiding underneath a vehicle to the east of 51 E. 6th St.

I responded to their location and saw the male they had detained in handcuffs was the same male I saw open the driver's door of the Mercedes before fleeing.

I spoke to [REDACTED] who resides at [REDACTED] 6th St. [REDACTED] informed me he had surveillance footage. The camera faced South on to E 6th St. I watched the surveillance footage and I could see as the Mercedes comes into camera angle and stops briefly. A black male driver wearing a White Shirt and Blue/Dark Jeans exits the drivers side of the vehicle and takes off running N/B. The vehicle coasts to a stop on the South side of the street. [REDACTED] advised he would create a copy of the footage and bring it to the PD.

AMR arrived on scene and transported [REDACTED] to Sutter Delta Medical Center to be cleared after the K-9 apprehension.

I attempted to contact the registered owner of the vehicle, but the phone went straight to voicemail.

Officer White recovered the vehicle and waited for A&M Tow. (Refer to his report for further details).

While at Sutter Delta Medical Center I read [REDACTED] his Miranda rights. I asked [REDACTED] if he understood his rights and he said, "Yeah".

[REDACTED] told me the following in summary:

He was not driving the vehicle and he was sitting in the passenger seat of the vehicle. He has no reason to be stealing vehicles. He does not want to tell the name of the driver.

When I asked him about me seeing him open the door he stated that it was not him. He continued denying that I saw him in the driver's seat of the vehicle.

When I confronted [REDACTED] about the video surveillance he states that he was sitting in the passenger seat and jumped across the drivers side to exit the vehicle. [REDACTED] also stated the camera did not capture the

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second person in the vehicle.

A short time later [REDACTED] admitted to driving the vehicle to the Chevron gas station and hearing me tell him to turn the vehicle off, but then he stated that he switched seats with his friend at the gas station. [REDACTED] friend was the one that took the police on a high speed.

I checked [REDACTED] criminal history and he had the following convictions:
