☐ Comments: Officer Sahnic received an ALPR alert to a stolen Mercedes and observed it pull into Chevron located at 2413 A Street. Officer Sahnic attempted contact with the driver after the vehicle was turned off. The driver, Arr-Anthony Mundine turned the vehicle on and drove away failing to yield for Officer Harger and Officer Sahnic. A pursuit for approx within city streets lasted for approx 2 minutes. The pursuit ended when Mundine fled from the vehicle and was apprehended with assistance from Officer Harger's police service dog. Arr-Mundine was treated at Sutter Delta for injuries sustained during the arrest. He was medically cleared and transported to MDF for evading, possession of a stolen vehicle, and resisting.
